### After School Clubs

The School Council have worked with children and staff this week to review our after school club provision and plan some new clubs that the children would like to attend.

We will be sending out our new selection on Monday so that you can book into the clubs that your child would like. Spaces in some clubs will be limited to ensure the quality of the club can remain as high a standard as possible, so act quickly to secure your place. If your child already attends recorder or choir club, they will continue to keep their place.

If you do not hear from school, you can assume that your child has been booked in to all clubs that were requested.

We are also exploring some additional after school clubs that will be delivered by external providers. We will update you when we can regarding these.

### Lunchtime Clubs

Our Year 5 and Year 6 School Councillors have worked together to set up some lunchtime clubs that the KS1 & KS2 children will be able to attend. They have worked alongside the other members of their class to ensure that the clubs are well 'staffed' and will be organising rooms and resources with me next week to ensure that the clubs are a success! These clubs include board game club, lego club, maths club, colouring club, homework club and Dinosaur Club. This is giving our children the opportunity to develop their leadership skills within school. They are enthusiastic and excited to get going with these clubs.
