


Science Week Reminder

School Meals

We have been informed by our catering provider that, from April 2024, the cost of a school meal will increase from £2.83 to £2.95.

This is due to a number of factors including an increase in the cost of food, an increase in the minimum wage.

If your child is in receipt of free school meals, this will not effect them and they will continue to have access to free school meals. You can check if you eligible for free school meals by clicking [HERE](#).

Please remember that eligibility is not just a reflection of your current circumstances. You are be eligible if you have been eligible at any point in the past 6 years, so we would encourage you to take the time to check.
