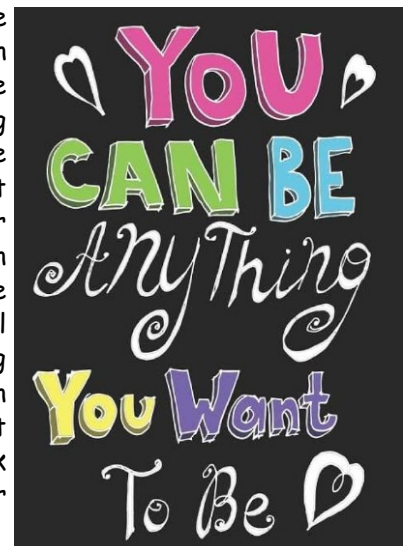
Autumn dates were sent out in September, so please refer to these to ensure you are aware of future dates.
